SECTION 390.025 MOTORIZED BICYCLES, HELMETS REQUIRED

- A. Every person operating a motorized bicycle as defined in RSMo §307.180, anywhere within the city limits shall wear protective headgear at all times that the vehicle is in motion. The headgear shall meet reasonable standards and specifications established by the state director of the Department of Public Safety.
- B. The maximum penalty for a violation of the provisions in this section is twenty-five dollars (\$25.00). No court costs shall be imposed upon any person due to such violation.

SECTION 390.027 MOTORIZED BICYLES, MANNER OF OPERATION

- C. No person shall operate a motorized bicycle on any highway, street or roadway inside the city limits unless such person has a valid motor vehicle operator's license.
- D. No motorized bicycle may be operated on or along a highway, street, roadway or public thoroughfare located within the city which has a speed limit greater than thirty-five (35) miles per hour, except for the purpose of crossing such a roadway at an intersection.
- E. A person operating a motorized bicycle shall ride only upon the permanent and regular seat attached thereto, and such operator shall not carry any other person, nor shall any other person ride on a motorized bicycle anywhere within the city limits.
- F. It shall be unlawful for any person to ride, operate or manage any motorcycle or motorized bicycle other than in a seated position thereon with one (1) leg on either side thereof, except that the provisions of this article shall not apply to vehicles with three (3) or more wheels.
- G. No person shall ride a motorcycle or motorized bicycle on any street without having his hands upon the handle bars, nor shall any person ride a motorcycle or motorized bicycle upon any sidewalk, walkway or footpath within the city.
